

Calf Club & Pet Day 2020 Entry Form

- Please complete this form if you wish to enter an animal, hanging basket, bird box, or hobbit house on Calf Club & Pet Day.
- Entries must be received by the School office before Friday 18 September.
- Forms must be printed off and handed to the office, or signed forms can be scanned and emailed to office@oropi.school.nz
- Parents or Caregivers must sign below to validate their child's entry.
- All calves that attend a school pet day must be tagged with a NAIT approved RFID ear tag and registered with NAIT. There is no requirement for pet day participants to record animal movements to and from school pet days. If you have purchased a calf from a farmer or the sale yards, it is your responsibility to ensure it is registered with NAIT and that it has a NAIT tag before calf club day. Any calves with NO NAIT TAG are not eligible to attend calf club. You can find further information on the following website www.nait.co.nz.
- One calf, lamb, or goat entry per child. You are not permitted to share an animal with siblings.
- One chicken entry per child. Chickens must be caged separately.
- One hanging basket entry per child.
- One Hobbit House entry per child.
- One Bird Box entry per child
- Best Dressed Pet is open to any animal. All animals must be on a lead at all times.

Animals must comply with the dates below to enter.

Animals born before these dates will not qualify for ribbons or trophies.

- Calves **must be born** on or after 20 July
- Lambs **must be born** on or after 1st August
- Goats **must be born** on or after 1st August
- Chickens must have been ordered through the school to enter in the chicken competition. Other chickens can be entered under the Open Pet Section.

Age group information:

Junior children who are under 9 years of age on July 1st

Senior children who are 9 years of age or over on July 1st


